had her legs paralyzed and could hardly fold them to sit. The hardest things for her, was the time for toilet, she could do everything in the toilet standing, really bad. After we had prayed, laid hands on her and she could right there, freely move up and down. Gurue 12 people gave their lives to Jesus, during our 3 days of ministry there. All glory to Jesus.



**Water Baptism** - 7 people went through the water baptism and 15 were baptized in The Holy Spirit and a lot of deliverance took place at Gurue. It was very exciting moment, to see these many people being saved, healed and set free everywhere we go.

The church there is moving forward and The Kingdom of heaven is advancing in Mozambique. Thank you, for sowing into our lives and ministry

**God's promise of ownership** - Its was my first time in 4 years since the church strated at Gurue. Its God's promise, that every place our foot step on, its ours to establish for God's kingdom (Joshua 1.3).

### Zone 3 - Pebane District, Magiga.



We arrived at Magiga community and people were waiting for us, like a dry land longing for the rain for a long time. Soon upon our arrival, bit exhausted but strong enough to interact with the people, I heard words resounding “**Muhulupale ophia**” (makuwa dialect, meaning: The Big father has arrived. I thought to myself, I can’t miss a chance of infusing the joy of The Lord into these kids. I got some faces wild and somebody smiling and so here we are – Welcome to Magiga, Pebane!



There are no much Evangelical or Pentecostal churches around Magiga, mostly mosques, Roman Catholics and The 7<sup>th</sup> Day Adventist. **Afrika Wa Yesu**, is carrying the lamp of Jesus and standing firm, despite of every Islamic culture cemented in the minds of many of people.

**Hope, Faith and Love** - These three elements, found in 1Cor. 13.13, is we see sanding ad infused into the hearts our brothers and sisters there. We showed Jesus movie, evangelized, taught the leaders, worked with the children and strengthened the local body. During the Jesus movie, we could see a long bench far at the end of the crowd, full of heads with the white caps - were the born Moslems, watching the Jesus movie. Though, they usually don’t

come forward but many are being touched and forever changed inwardly, for God’s glory. I believe its about time for great turn around at Magiga church. The man with the long trousers is a mosque leader, his 2 sons, are local church leaders. What a change.



Please keep these brothers in prayer. The Moslems had come to burn our church with people inside, on one Sunday, at the beginning of our church there and the resistance is so tense there.

**Zone 4 - Ratata Community**, is a daughter church under Magiga, located some 40km away from Magiga village. It's flourishing well, in the middle of nowhere. The picture on the right below is Ratata. We inaugurated the building one week ago.



**Zona 5 - Nacavala:** The work is moving forward and during our ministry there, we were able lift the leadership on another dimension and strengthen church. We have 5 churches under Nacavala and we gathered all the leaders in one place for training. I am very pleased to see each local church pulling together in evangelism and caring each other. We expect a lot of good things to continue growing up there. I am specially excited to see the church's eagerness to reach their own fellow-countrymen and unreached communities around.

**Zone 6 - Odinepa**, is located some 280km north of Nampula city. As soon as we arrived, kids from every walk, curiously watch our camp set up. Never seen before a moving house - Tent. All is new.



**Breakfast:** Some boiled bananas mixed with mashed tomato and some onions, comes out a perfect breakfast, distant from home. I enjoyed it so much. It's a typical 7 star dish around here. We taught on Assurance of Salvation, Holy Spirit Baptism, church leadership, becoming the fishers of men and did show the Jesus movie and the out come was tremendous. The church has over 80 members.



**Zone 7 - Muapatia** - Is located 185km away from Nampula city. The church is alive and full of fire. There is such a strong leadership under brother Agostinho, who have recently graduated from our bible school.



**Salvation** - About 30 adult people received Christ, through the Jesus movie and 12 people responded the appeal for the assurance of



salvation inside the church several were baptized in The Holy Spirit and over 25 people were set free from various bondage in their lives. Marriages were restored, leadership structured and instructed to lead with love, passion and compassion.

It was Paul's custom visiting churches where had been (Acts 15.36-16.1-4), I will be visiting some of these places later this year. *I am very happy with what I am doing for The Lord.*

**The widows, orphans and the needy poor people.** During our trip, it was difficult to find what was needed to help these needy people. *But we have identified and will be making plan on how we can best help them. Will plan ways to go back with some supplies soon.*



The Lord is doing great things in Mozambique. The Good News is being proclaimed in the four corners of our nation. We are seeing people being saved through the evangelistic efforts, healings and people being restored. Disciples made, leaders trained and churches planted. This fulfills what The Lord has called me to do.



**A Portable electrical generator** is what we use for providing power, to project the Jesus movie every place we go to minister. Last week Wednesday, 10 minutes before we started showing the movie, the fuel pump got broken, we had to adapt, improvise and overcome the obstacle in order to reach our goal. Found an empty water bottle, made a small holes front and back and got things rolling. Vehicle maintenance, travelling expenses are some of the challenges we face, BUT God.
